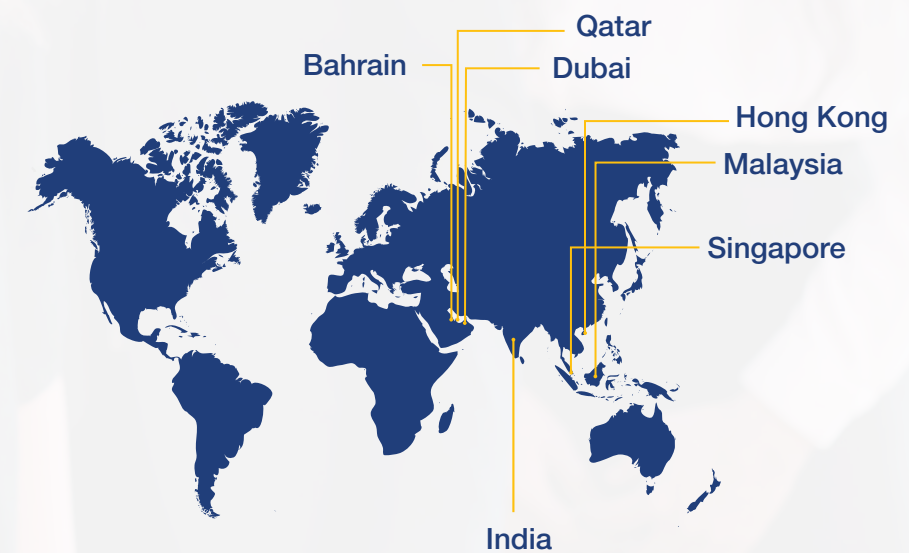

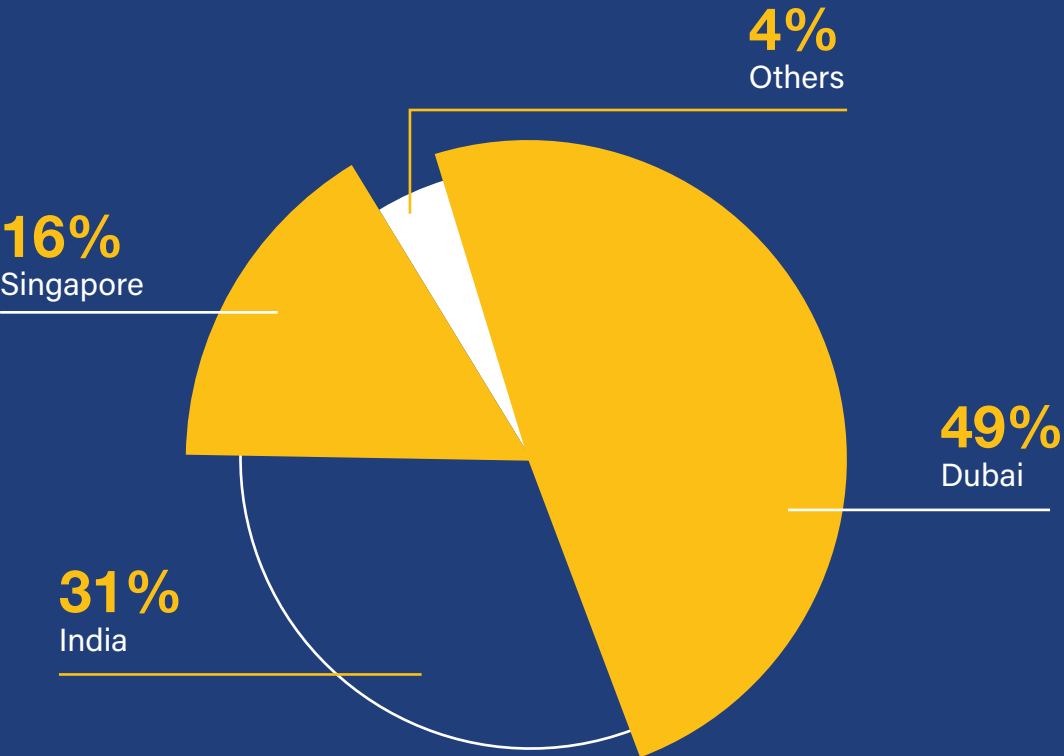

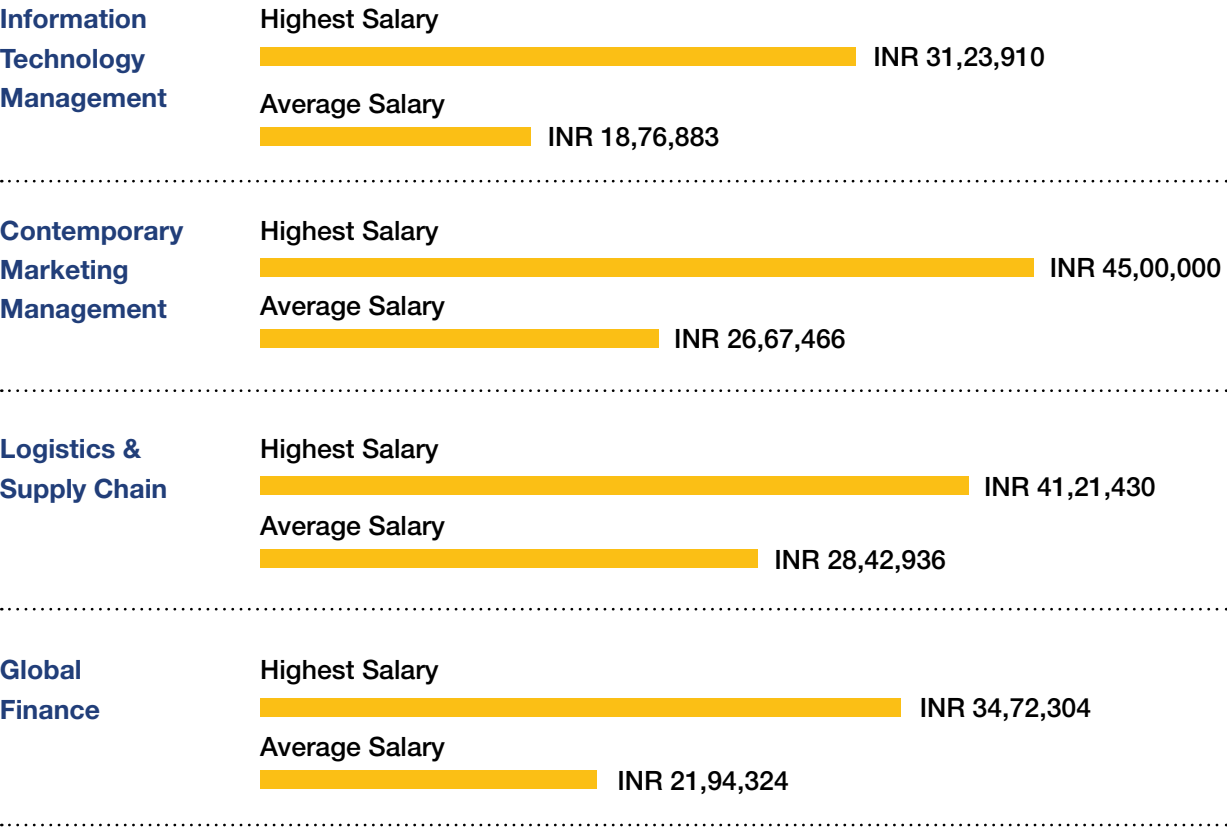

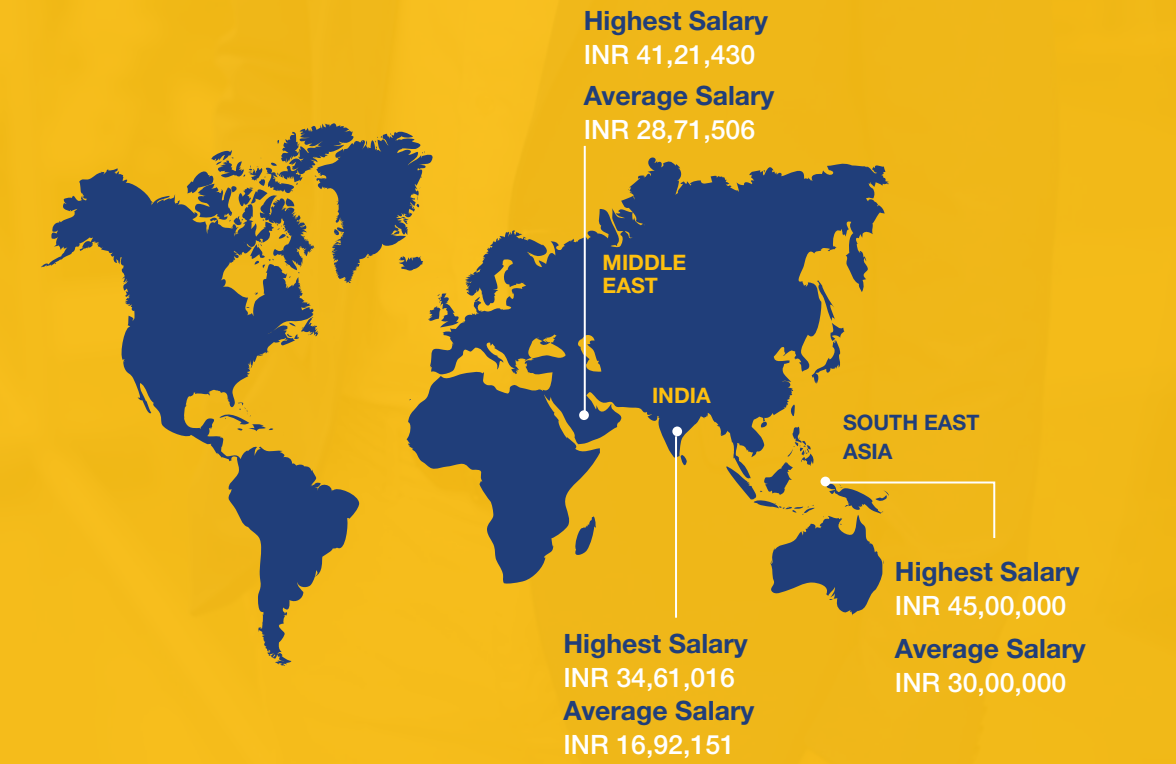
In just 12 months, the S P Jain Class of 2018 graduated with a 3-fold-jump in average starting salaries.

## Graduate Salaries (by region)

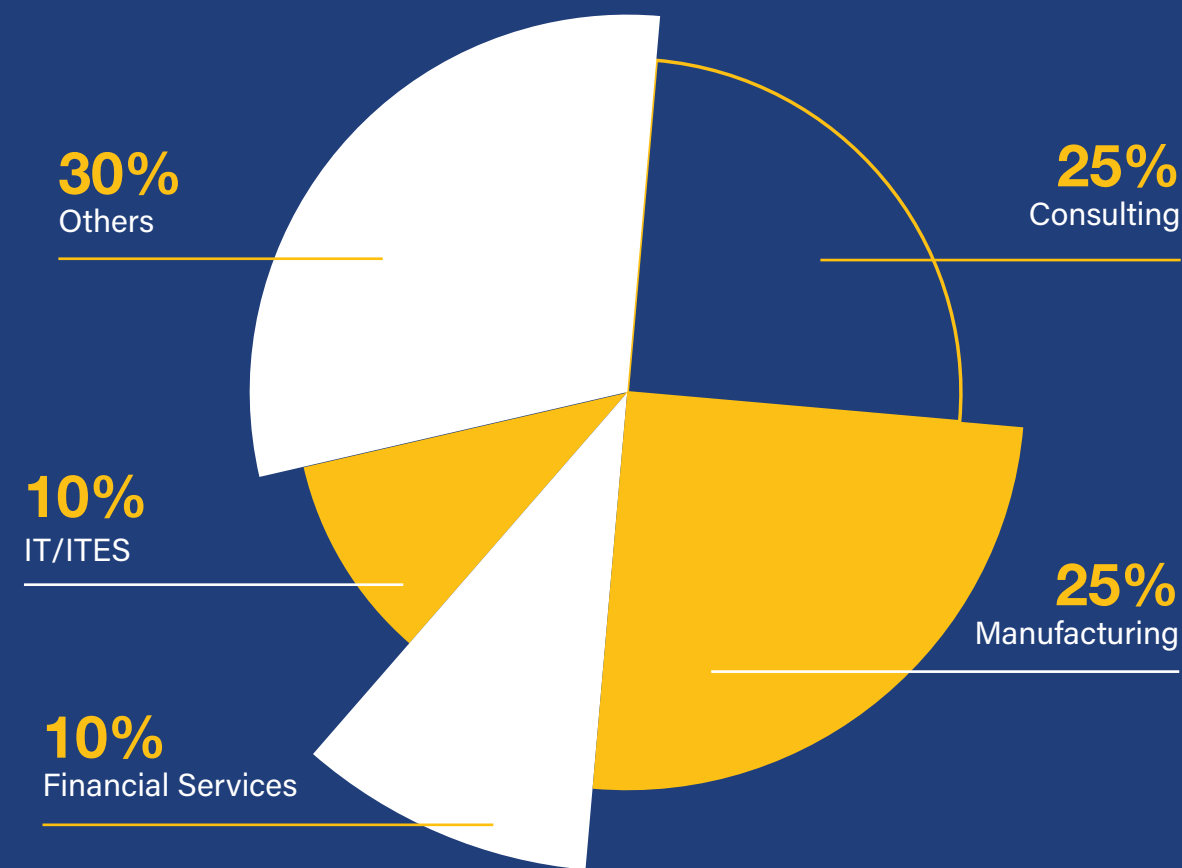

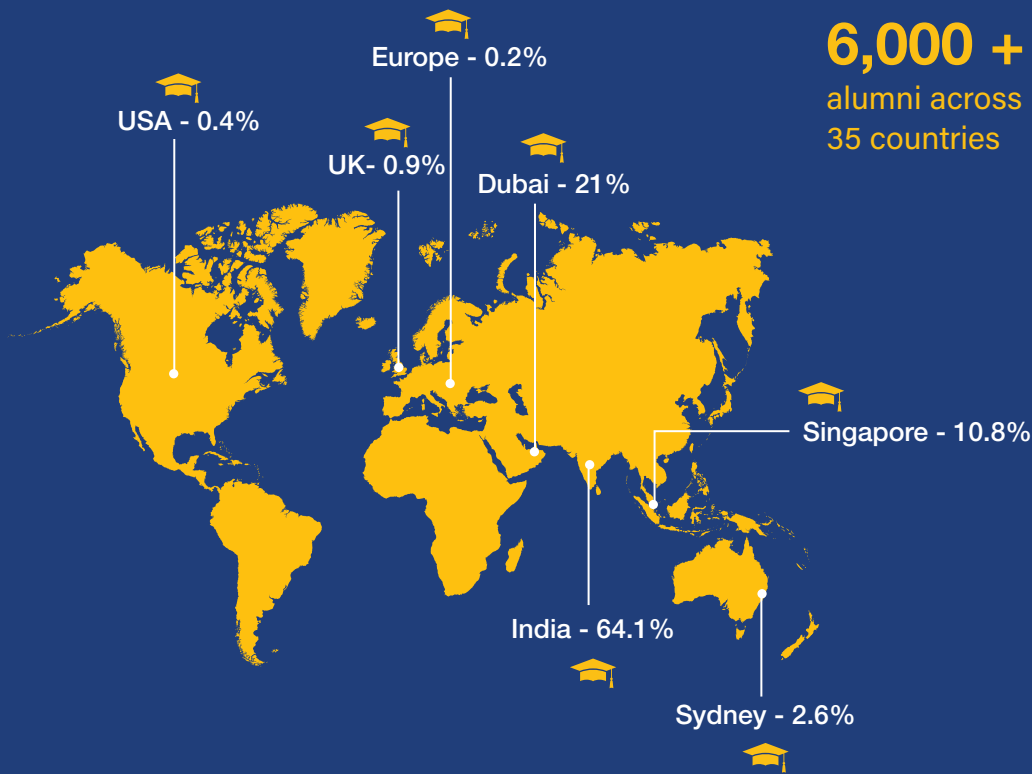

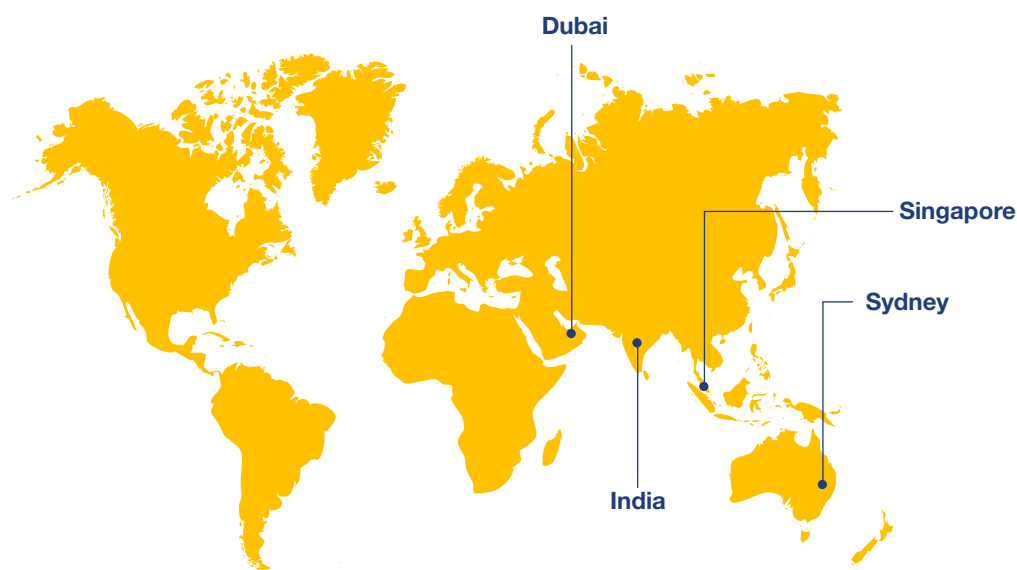
